Everyone will be measured Nov. 13 (Sat) in their class time and all re-

maining students will need to come in SOMETIME between 10 am and 4 pm to be measured. Once again wearing dance attire makes the measuring process much easier and time efficient.

The dressmaker requires a

deposit of \$100 per costume. These deposits are due in our office by Saturday, October 30th. The balance of the costume cost is due when the costumes arrive. A second deposit will be required for all the competitive company costumes by January 15th.

**NOTE:** Without a deposit, we are unable to order your child's costume. Remember that costume deposits are non-refundable and non transferable.

**TINY TOES PARENTS:** Costume deposits are not required at this time. Information with regard to participation in the year-end show and the costume cost will be forwarded to you in January.
